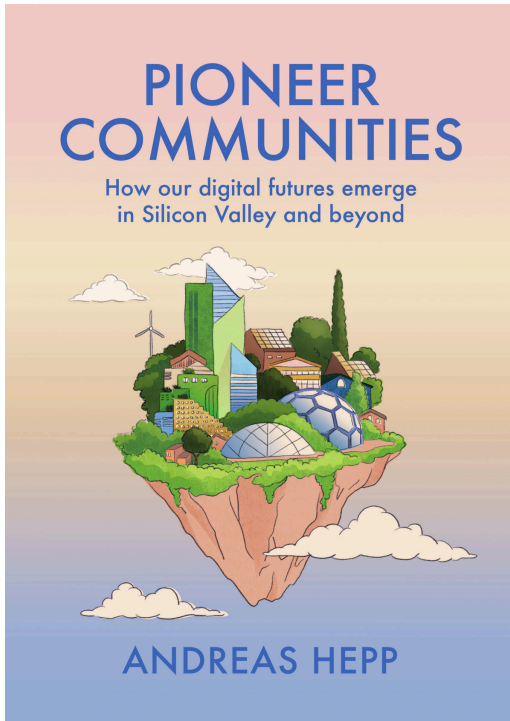

The book reveals how these communities foster a “quiet futuring”, a process that, though often unseen, profoundly impacts our perceptions of technological advancement.
